Adaptations



- Adaptations can be structural or behavioural.
- An organism with structural adaptations has body parts that assist in its survival in its natural habitat.
- An organism with behavioural adaptations does something that helps in its survival in its natural habitat.
- Adaptations serve to enhance the survival of organisms by enabling them to
 - cope with physical factors
 - obtain food
 - escape predators
 - reproduce by finding and mating with their mates
 - reproduce by dispersal of seeds
