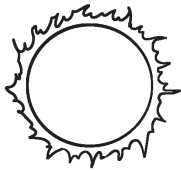


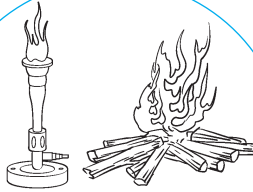
Heat and temperature

Things that produce heat are known as **sources of heat**.



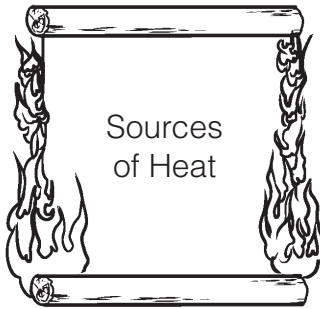
Sun (our main heat source)

Rubbing two hands together



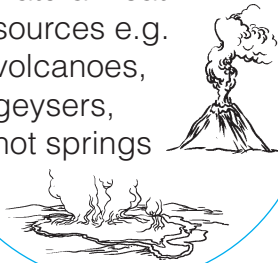
Burning fuels e.g. wood, charcoal, petroleum, natural gas
