An **adjectival phrase** describes the noun or pronoun in a sentence.

Adjectival phrases can contain more than one adjective.

- The weather is **hot and humid**.
- The players are **skilful and disciplined**.
- She is really **hungry and tired**.
- His grandfather is **old and weak**.

Adjectival phrases can also begin with a preposition.

- The umbrella **with a broken handle** belongs to Kate.
- The man **behind the counter** is the owner.
- The bicycle **in the shade** is mine.
- The lady **beside Mary** is our English teacher.
