- **Where** are you going?

We use '**when**' to ask questions about **timing**.

- **When** is your birthday?
- **When** are you leaving?

We use '**how**' to ask questions to **find out more**.

- **How** do you feel today?
- **How** do you get to the station?

We use '**why**' to ask questions to **find out the reasons**.

- **Why** does Ray look so sad?
- **Why** are you late?

We use '**which**' to ask questions to **find out about choices**.

- **Which** is your favourite watch?
- **Which** car is more expensive?
