executed	: put to death
famine	: scarcity of food

feeble	: old and weak
ignored	: paid no attention to
illegal	: not allowed by the law
illegible	: difficult to read
immediately	: without delay
immortal	: live forever
infallible	: could never make mistakes
invisible	: cannot be seen
meagre	: very small
mob	: noisy and angry crowd
notorious	: well-known but in a bad way
omit	: leave out
panic	: sudden great fear
promoted	: given a higher post
regretted	: felt sorry
repeatedly	: again and again
screamed	: gave a loud, sharp cry
skinny	: very thin
starving	: do not have enough food to eat
sympathise	: feel sorry
uninhabited	: not populated
