The **simple present tense** refers to **actions that happen at the present moment**. It is also used to refer to things that are **true**.

Review these.

- The sun **rises** every morning.
- He **works** from nine to six every day.
- I **like** mathematics.

The **simple past tense** is used to refer to **actions that happened in the past**.

Review these.

- The boys **played** soccer yesterday.
- We **went** on a tour last week.
- A snake **bit** him on the leg just now.

The **simple future tense** is used to show that **an action will take place in the future**.

Review these.

- They **will go** to the beach tomorrow.
- He **will start** on the new project at the end of the week.
- The ambulance **will arrive** in a few minutes.
