Sometimes, two or more adjectives are used to describe nouns.

When we use more than one **adjective** to describe a noun, we have to arrange them in a special order:

**determiner (number)** → **observations** → size → shape → age → colour → origin → material

number	size	colour	noun
several	tiny	white	mice
two	fat	black	cats
