Sometimes, **two or more adjectives** are used to describe nouns.

When we use more than one **adjective** to describe a noun, we have to arrange them in a special order:

determiner (number) → **observations** → **size** → **shape** → **age**
→ **colour** → **origin** → **material**

number	size	colour	noun
several	tiny	white	mice
two	fat	black	cats
