A **descriptive adjective** tells us more about a noun.

A **possessive adjective** shows ownership or possession.

A **quantitative adjective** tells us the number or amount of something.

Review these.

- Wendy has **many** toys.
- She made **some** sandwiches for the picnic.
- Flowers always attract **a lot of** insects.
- Only **a few** people turned up to watch the match.
- There is **a little** soup in the pot.

A **demonstrative adjective** points out something or someone.

Review these.

- **This** is a sword.
- **These** toys belong to my sister.
- **Those** books belong to Miss Lee.
- Do you know **that** boy?
