## PRONOUNS

### REVIEW

**Personal pronouns** are used to **replace nouns or noun phrases**.

They can be used as a **subject or an object of a verb**.

**Review these.**

- Betty entered the lift. A man followed **her**.
- The man was smoking. **She** asked **him** to stop smoking, but **he** ignored **her**.
- I scored two goals in the soccer match. The coach praised **me**.

**Possessive pronouns** are used **to show ownership or possession**.

**Review these.**

- This wallet belongs to me. It is **mine**.
- That car belongs to them. It is **theirs**.

**Reflexive pronouns** are used **to show that the action in a sentence affects the doer**.

**Emphatic pronouns** are used **to emphasise the importance of the action or the doer**.

**Review these.**

- Suddenly I found **myself** in a dark alley.
- The cat injured **itself** in the fight.
- He **himself** must complete the project.
- They **themselves** must plan the training for the competition.
