### REVIEW

The **present continuous tense** is used to talk about actions which are going on as we are speaking about them.

Pronoun / Noun	Verb in present continuous tense
I	am + <b>verb</b> + ing
he, she, it, mother	is + <b>verb</b> + ing
you, we, they, the boys, the birds	are + <b>verb</b> + ing

### Review these.

- I **am walking** to school.
- My father **is talking** on the phone.  
He **is talking** to my teacher.
- Janet **is standing** by the door.  
She **is waving** to a friend.
- The cat **is drinking** in the kitchen.  
It **is drinking** from its bowl.
- You **are writing** a composition.
- My cousin and I **are playing** in the garden.  
We **are catching** spiders.
- The children **are visiting** the museum.  
They **are doing** a project.
