- We use '**that**' for people, animals and things.
- We use '**which**' for animals and things.
- We use '**whose**' as a possessive.

- This is the boy **who** was crying at the train station.
- The woman, **whom** we met, is my neighbour.
- The fruiterer, from **whom** you bought the fruit, is my uncle.
- Do you know the man **that** owns this shop?
- The woman, **that** we met, is my teacher.
- This is the book **that** I lent to James.
- This is the book **which** I lent to James.
- This is the toaster **which** I bought yesterday.
- The boy, **whose** painting has been selected for the exhibition, is very happy.
- That is the woman **whose** car was stolen yesterday.
