Relative pronouns are used to join sentences. They provide more information about the subject of the sentence.

Review these.

- The woman carried the baby. She was my aunt.
The woman **who** carried the baby was my aunt.
- The boy stopped the fight. He was a school prefect.
The boy **who** stopped the fight was a school prefect.
- The man robbed Mrs Brown. He had curly hair.
The man **who** robbed Mrs Brown had curly hair.
- The principal spoke to the man. The man was Alex's father.
The man **whom** the principal spoke to was Alex's father.
- I have a friend. Her mother drives a school bus.
I have a friend **whose** mother drives a school bus.
- Mrs Brown is looking for her cat. It has disappeared.
Mrs Brown is looking for her cat **which** has disappeared.
- This is the man. He was hiding from the police.
This is the man **that** was hiding from the police.
- This is the tree. It has a nest on one of its branches.
This is the tree **that** has a nest on one of its branches.
