Review these.

We use '**shall**' with pronouns '**I**' and '**we**'.

- **I shall** be a doctor when I grow up.
- **I shall** go to the park tomorrow.
- **We shall be** veterinarians when we grow up.
- **We shall** visit the zoo next week.

We use '**will**' with pronouns '**he**', '**she**', '**it**' and '**they**'.

- Mr Gopal, my neighbour, **will** go to India next week.
He will stay for a month.
- **He will** buy a bicycle next month.
- Fiona **will** come to my house tomorrow. **She will** bring her sticker album.
- **She will** bake pizza for dinner.
- The cat is hungry. **It will** look for food.
- **They will** finish their work tomorrow.
